Nursery 3 & 4 year olds will be learning to...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show attention to sounds and music. • Respond emotionally and physically to music when it changes. • Anticipate phrases and actions in rhymes and songs. • Make rhythmical and repetitive sounds. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move and dance to music. • Explore a range of sound makers and instruments and play them in different ways. • Enjoy and take part in action songs, such as 'Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star'. • Create their own songs or improvise a song around one they know. • Play instruments with increasing control to express their feelings and ideas. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore their voices and enjoy making sounds. • Join in with songs and rhymes, making some sounds. • Remember and sing entire songs. • Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person ('pitch match'). • Sing the melodic shape (moving melody, such as up and down, down and up) of familiar songs.
Reception 4 & 5 year olds will be learning to...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses. • Watch and talk about dance and performance art, expressing their feelings and responses. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody.
