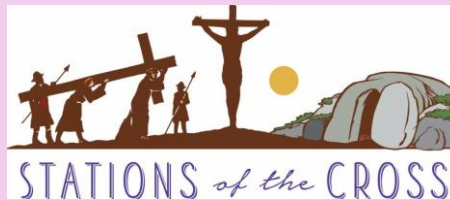

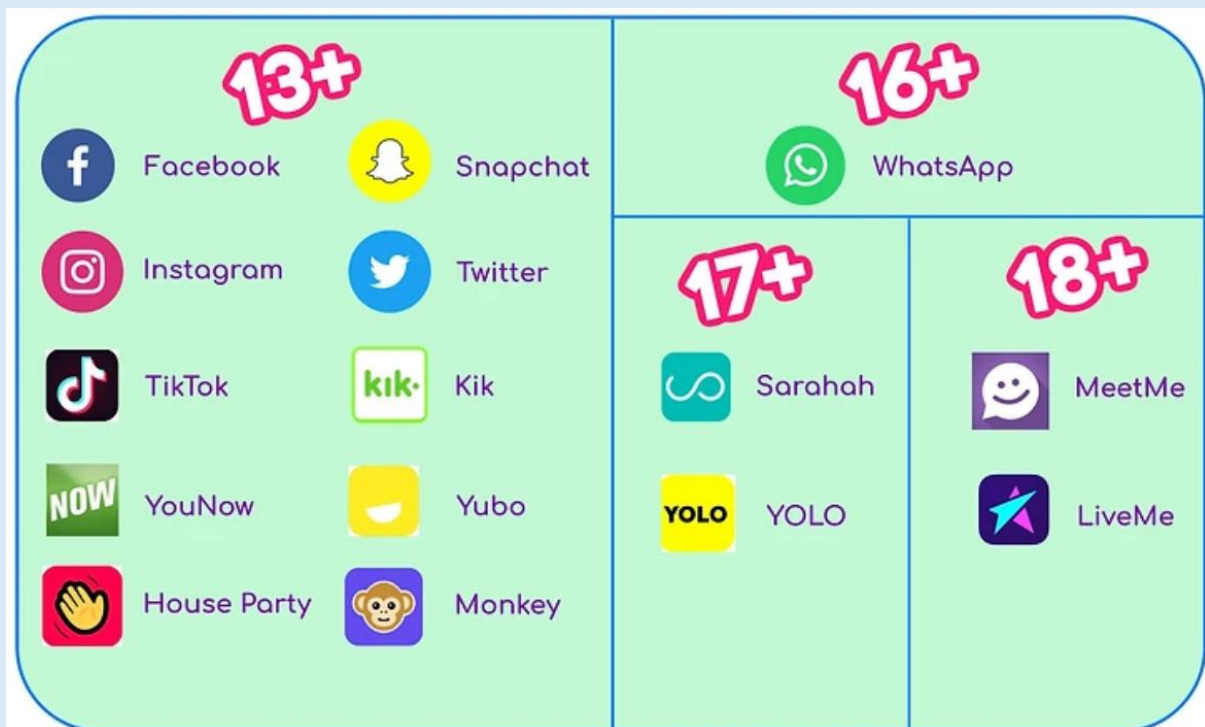
Social Media
